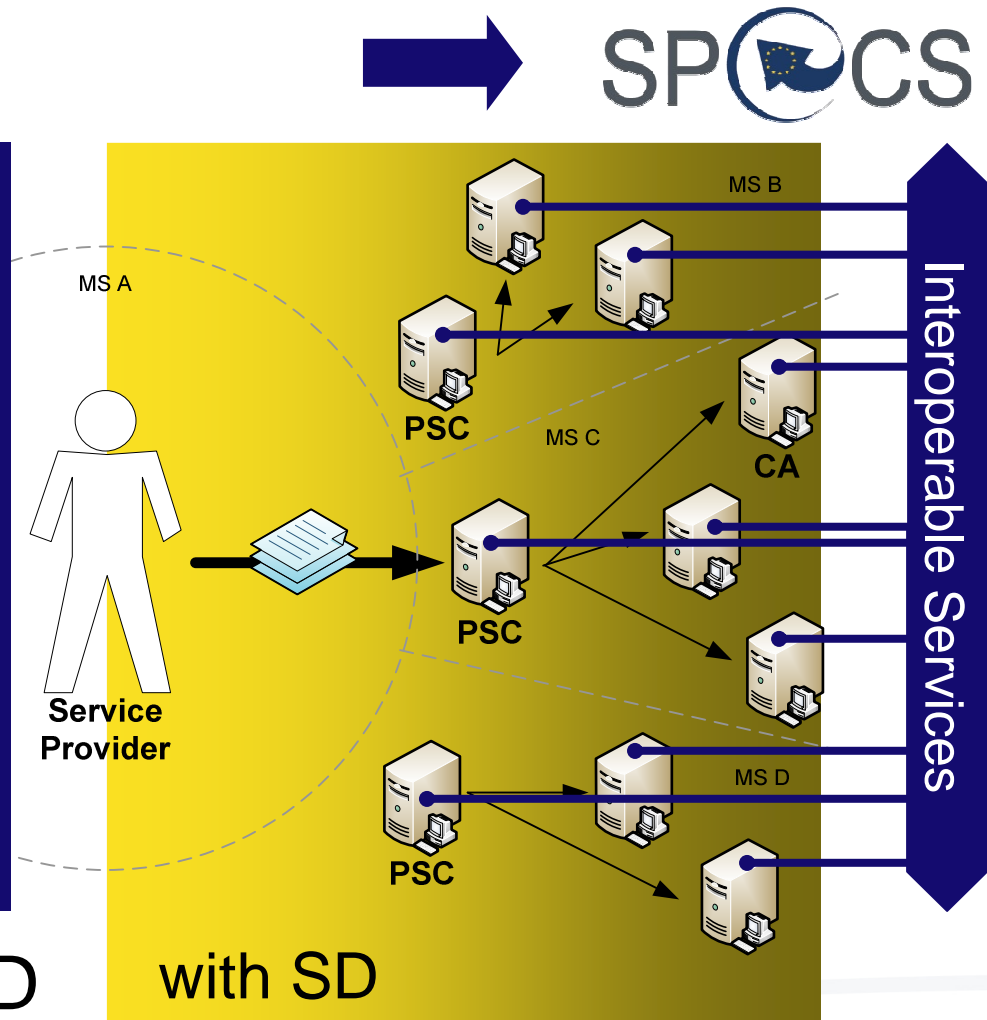
# The services directive today

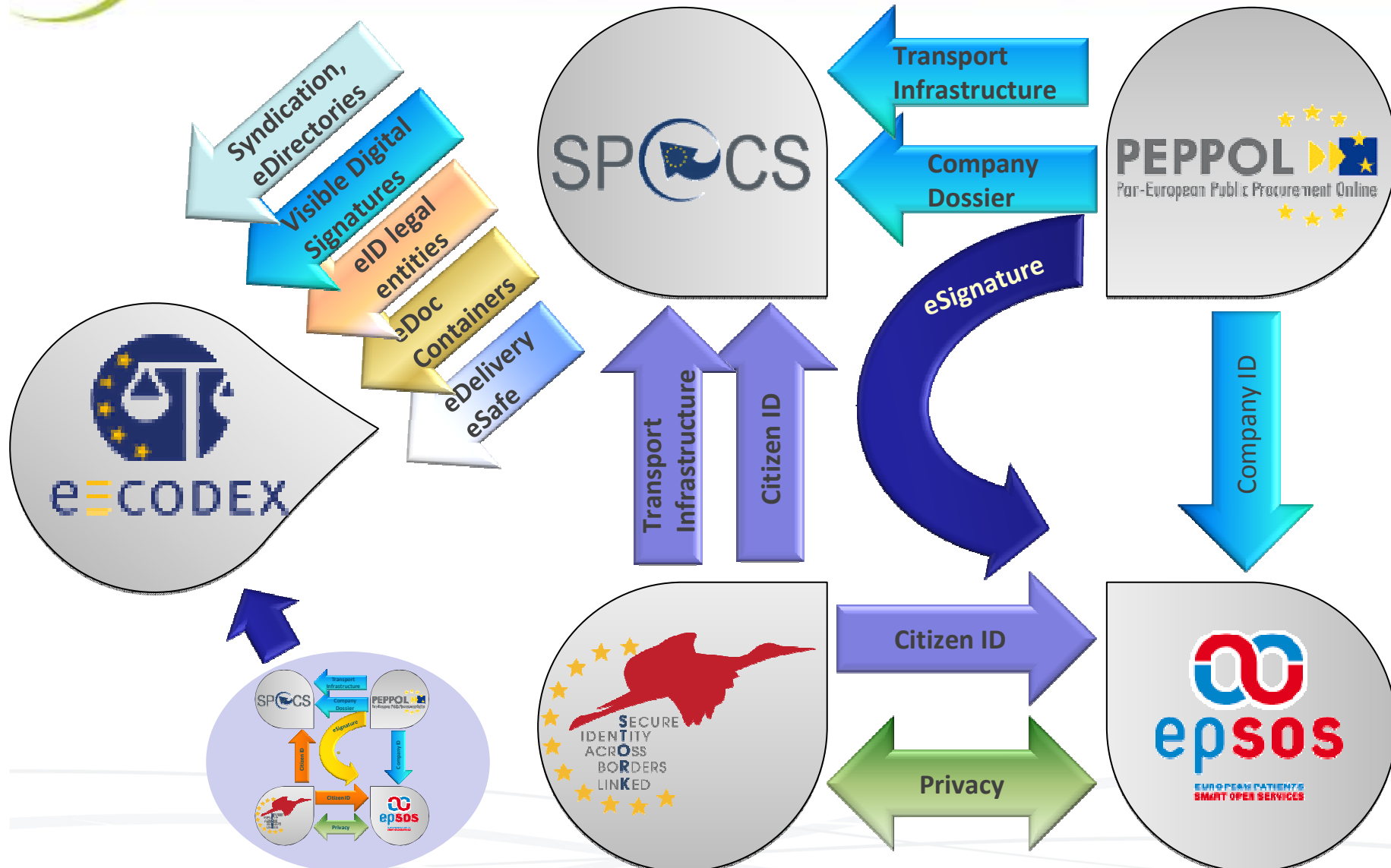
