# BraveHealth

## The Project Vision

The Kick-off event of the FP7 Integrated Project “**BRAVEHEALTH**”, co-funded by the European Commission with 7M€, is the ideal occasion for gathering together all the stakeholders of the e-health field, under the supervision of the **European Commission**. The issue is clear: over the last few years we have read astonishing data regarding the huge impact of chronic diseases, and in particular **Cardio-vascular diseases (CVD)** on European citizens and on EU economy. E-health has long been regarded as one of the most promising and powerful solutions to this issue, and will ensure **an increase in the quality of care delivered and in the quality of life delivered to patients, whilst decreasing the overall healthcare costs**.

It is evident that, besides lots of interesting pilot projects across Europe, the use of e-Health services for supporting remote management of CVD **is still very limited**. E-health currently lacks a standardised approach, the market remains highly fragmented and, critically, no valid approach for Dynamic Decision Support to Clinicians and Risk Assessment of CVD is available to the medical community. Although Member States have expressed their commitment to a wider deployment of e-Health for CVD treatment, most initiatives are no more than one-off, small-scale projects that are not pervasively integrated into each country’s healthcare systems. **That’s why the representatives of the key players of this complex scenario are invited in this conference to identify their standpoint**, describing the benefits of a well established e-health framework and the setbacks encountered so far.

Finally, BRAVEHEALTH project will be presented as the **new solution** conceived to address all the stakeholders’ needs, starting with a cornerstone concept: **the patient must be at the center of this new ecosystem**.

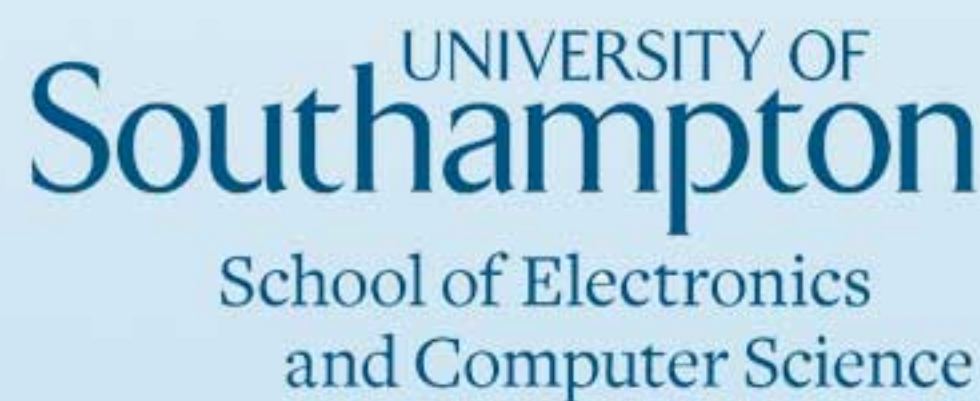
