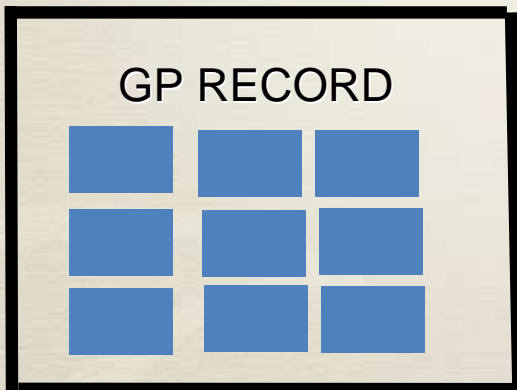
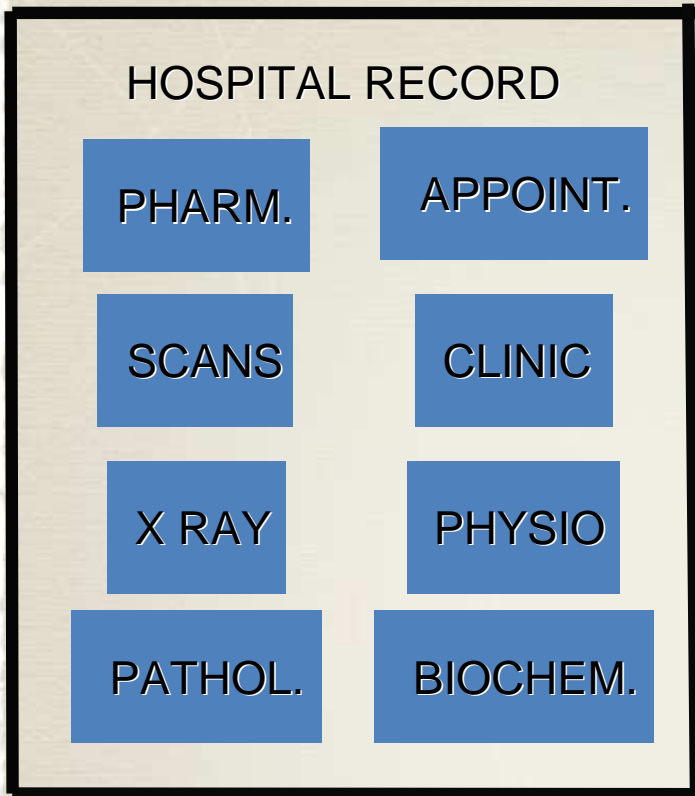


Integrated Care - who is involved?

 - Integrated care for multiple pathology
 - Team-based care
- Social care:
 - Home support
 - Community integration
- Patient:
 - Self monitoring and self care
 - Health literacy and information

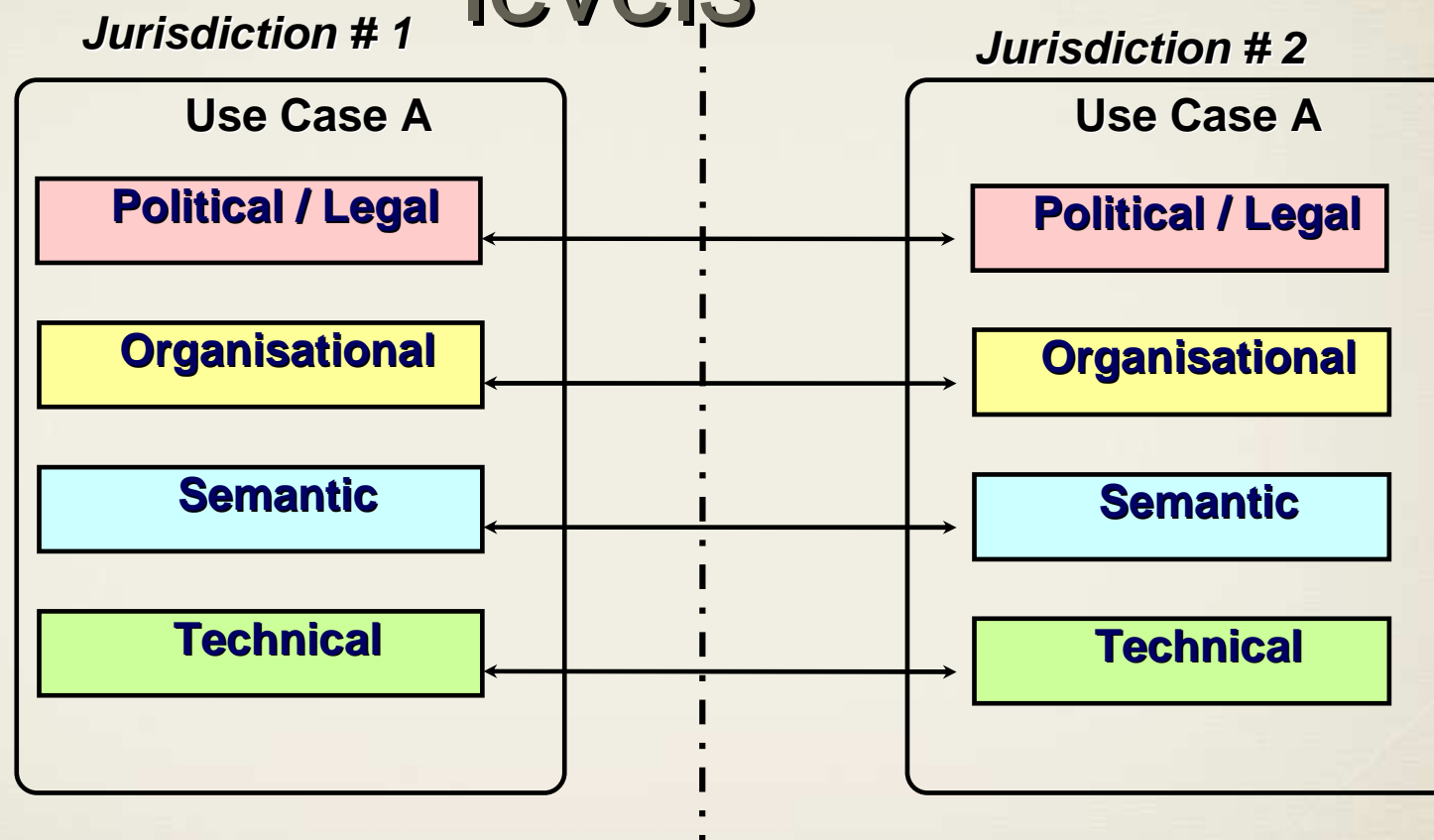
