

# EA Training 2.0

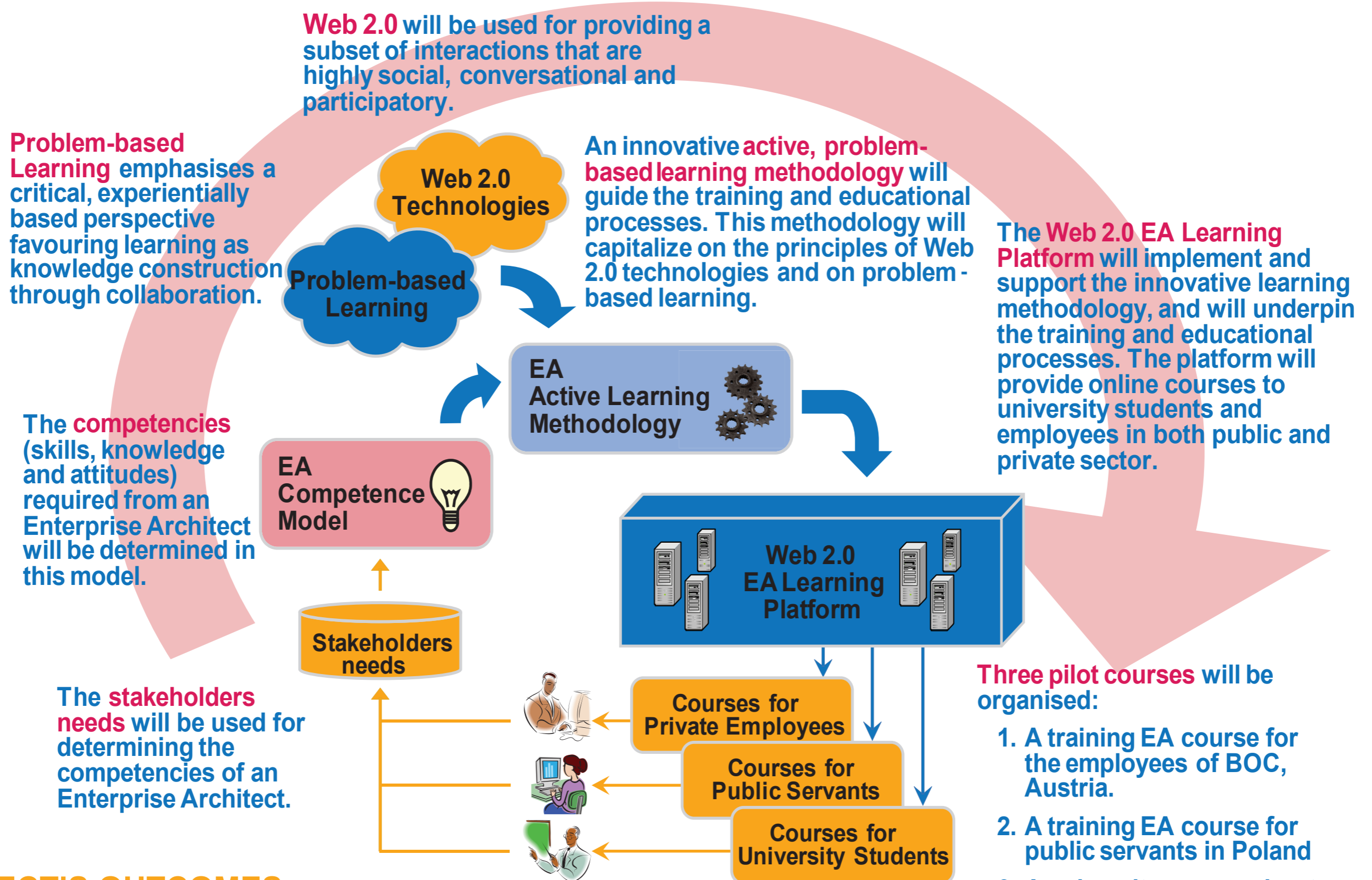
## Innovative Enterprise Architecture Education and Training Based on Web 2.0 Technologies

### PROJECT'S OBJECTIVES

- To determine the **profile of an Enterprise Architect** by identifying the required competencies.
- To determine the required **EA competencies** that **university students, public servants and private sector employees** need to acquire in order to become competent Enterprise Architects.
- To identify **new training and teaching methods**.
- To develop a **Web 2.0 EA learning platform** and course models for university students and employees.
- To undertake **pilot trials** for private and public sector employees and university students.

### WHY EATRaining 2.0?

An Enterprise Architecture (EA) is the process of translating business vision and strategy into effective enterprise change and it explains how the information systems, processes, organisational units and people in an organisation function as a whole. EA is essential for organizations in both public and private sector as it allows them to align complex business processes and it enables them to develop integrated vision and a global perspective. However, in Europe only few countries have noted EA programs and only a few universities have specialised courses. Furthermore, competencies required from an Enterprise Architect still need clarification.



### PROJECT'S OUTCOMES

- An **EA competence ontology** including a specification of an Enterprise Architect's skills;
- An **innovative, active problem-based learning methodology** for EA education and training;
- A **Web 2.0 EA learning platform** to support the developed methodology and underpin the training and learning processes;
- An **EA undergraduate course** for university students and **EA VET courses** for employees in private and public sector;
- **Pilot courses** for students and employees.

### Three pilot courses will be organised:

1. A training EA course for the employees of BOC, Austria.
2. A training EA course for public servants in Poland
3. A university course about EA in the University of Macedonia, Greece
