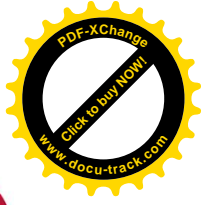

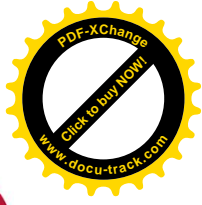


Founded in 1894, UL is an **independent, not-for-profit** organization.

- More than 70 Laboratory, Testing, and Certification Facilities



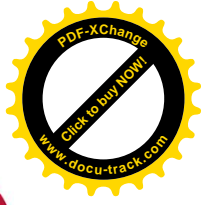
